Police Activity Updates

August 7th, 2017 through August 13th, 2017

A flatbed trailer was reported stolen from the area of 1550 E. 2525 N. overnight 8/8/17. The trailer's tongue lock had been cut.

On 8/9/17, a resident in the 1650 N. block of 450 E. reported that a wallet was stolen from an unlocked vehicle that was parked in the area on the evening of 8/7/17.

On 8/11/17, two residents in the 550 E. block of 2025 N. reported that solar lights had been stolen from their yards the previous afternoon. One of the residents advised that she confronted a juvenile who was approximately 8 yrs. old who was found tampering with her garden hose around the same time the lights were taken. In another incident at approximately the same time, a third resident in the same area reported that an unknown 8 yr. old juvenile came to his front door. The juvenile has not been identified at this time, and it is unknown if he was responsible for the lights being taken.

On 8/11/17, a resident in the 700 E. block of 2100 N. reported that someone had stolen two checks he had placed in his mailbox and attempted to cash them in Layton and Salt Lake City.

At approximately 1845 hrs. on 8/11/17, a resident in the 200 W. block of 1875 N. reported that an individual who came to test drive a vehicle that was for sale stole the vehicle after they took it for a test drive. The vehicle and suspect were later located in Utah County and the suspect was taken into custody.

While on break at 7-Eleven at approximately 0230 hrs. on 8/13/17, officers observed a motorist driving recklessly as he approached and pulled into the parking lot of the store. They approached the 18 year old driver to discuss his unsafe manner of driving. It was discovered that the driver's license was suspended or revoked, and that the vehicle he was driving's registration expired two years ago. The vehicle was impounded and the driver cited. A short time later, officers were called to the motorist's residence on a loud party complaint. The male was contacted again and advised to tone the party down. Officers also contacted the suspect's mother, who was out of town at the time, and advised her of what had taken place.

On 8/13/17, two residents in the 300 W. block of 1825 N. reported that items had been stolen from their unlocked vehicles overnight. One of the items stolen was a handgun.

On the afternoon of 8/13/17, two residents in the 1700 N. block of 300 W. reported that items had been stolen from their unlocked vehicles overnight.

On the afternoon of 8/13/17, a resident in the 300 W. block of 1775 N. reported that items had been stolen from her unlocked vehicle sometime on 8/12/17. She advised that she was not going to report the incident until she noticed an officer at another house in the neighborhood.

On the evening of 8/13/17, police were dispatched to a residence in the 1700 N. block of Diane Dr. A resident reported that items had been stolen from her unlocked vehicle overnight 8/12/17 while it was parked at this address.

This update highlights police activity for the time frame noted, but does not comprise a complete list of activity. Law enforcement sensitive cases, on-going investigations, and many other cases are not included.
