She has attended many city council, planning commission meetings.

At the same time, she served as secretary for the Weber County Junior posse and serves on the pre-rodeo committee. She has also been an superindant at the Weber County Fair for the Junior Posse and over the past several years she has been involved in the Weber Junior Lacrosse program and hopes that as a member of the council can help develop the area to the south of the Junior Posse arena on Mountain road into a Sports complex for all to enjoy.
