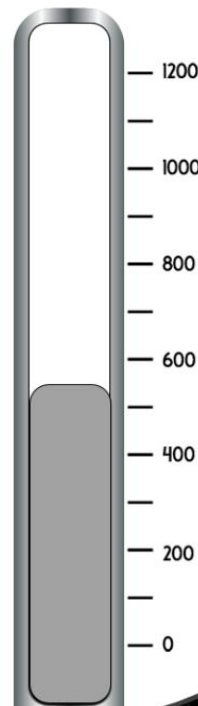

### MAYOR'S MESSAGE

July was a fantastic month for North Ogden, kicked off by an awesome Cherry Days festivity on our nation's birthday. I want to highlight the incredible work of our city staff and community volunteers in planning and executing a highly successful and well-attended celebration of our freedoms and our community history. Your city government has also been very busy with multiple road repair and public utility projects. We also have made major changes to traffic flow on 3100 north east of Washington Blvd. We have added left turn lanes at most intersections. We also created a "no parking or stopping" zone south of Bates Elementary, and moved the crosswalk and installed a pedestrian activated flashing light to assist children crossing 3100 North. These changes were made after months of analysis and public input and will greatly improve safety.

We are also implementing a program to encourage recycling. This is something we all need to get involved with, as our recycling rate as a city has actually been declining. In 2011 North Ogden residents recycled 1,058 tons, but in 2013 we recycled only 823 tons. We can do better by simply focusing on what garbage we are throwing into which can. Recycling matters more than ever to the city, as Weber County has implemented a new payment program for recycled goods. We can all save ourselves money and keep our utility fees low by simply recycling more. To help in this effort the City Council has approved a plan to increase the cost of additional garbage cans, while reducing the cost of additional recycling cans. Please consider getting a second recycling can for only \$2.65 per month and fill them up with recyclable goods. I have personally signed up for a second recycle can and encourage you to do the same. We have set a goal to recycle 1,200 tons this year—a big goal! By remembering to use the blue can as much as possible, we will meet that goal together!



**2014 Recycling Goal: 1,200 tons**

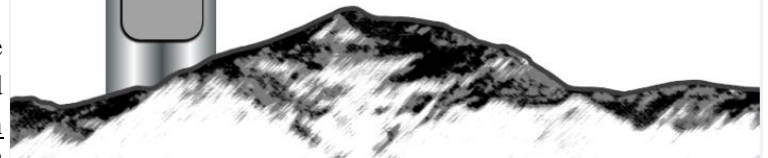
Progress to Date: 561 tons (46% of goal)

The Public Works Department and City Forester would like to draw your attention to the trees in your yard that overhang the curb and gutter and ask that you trim those to a minimum height of nine feet (9') above the curb and gutter and back so they don't hang into the roadway.

Beginning in October, city employees will be around the city trimming those trees that have not been trimmed. The trimming done by the city will be for functionality and may not be esthetically pleasing. Residents are asked to comply with the requested trimmings for the best results.

The green waste facility is open for the disposal of your trimmings on Mondays and Wednesdays from 3pm to 6pm and Saturdays 9am to 2pm. Pick up a punch pass at the city office during business hours. We greatly appreciate your cooperation.

**City Code 11-8D-5-A2:** "Landscaping materials shall be contained so as not to spill into the public right of way."

**City Code 11-8D-5-A3:** "...trees in the park strip shall have a minimum height of seven feet (7') for the lowest branches of the tree when they extend above the curb or sidewalk."

**City Code 11-8D-5-A4:** "Any damage to city property created by vegetation will be the responsibility of the property owner."

**City Code 11-10-11-A:** "...no fence, hedge, or other similar structure shall be erected in any required front yard of a lot to a height in excess of three and one-half feet (3.5')

It's almost time to start the new school year. We would like to take this opportunity to remind motorists that there will be an increase in pedestrian traffic as children begin their annual trek to school, and to remind motorists, pedestrians and other citizens of a few rules to keep our community safe:

**MOTORISTS:**

- The speed limit in a school zone with flashing yellow lights is 20 mph.
- Motorists must stop for the crossing guard anytime he/she is in the crosswalk and the stop sign is visible, regardless of which side of the road the crossing guard is on.
- When approaching a stopped school bus from either direction that has its red lights flashing, motorists must stop and remained stopped until the lights stop flashing and the bus is moving.
- Pedestrians have the right of way in a crosswalk.
- Do not stop at the red curb to pick up, drop off, or wait for students.
- When backing out of your driveway, check to make certain there are no pedestrians behind your vehicle before proceeding. Stop prior to the sidewalk to check for pedestrians.
- When stopped at an intersection, stop behind the white "stop" line or crosswalk. If there are no markings on the roadway, stop far enough back from the intersection to allow for pedestrians to cross safely in front of your vehicle.



**PEDESTRIANS:**

- Do not enter the roadway until you know motorists are aware of your presence and have stopped.
- Cross at the crosswalk, not mid-block. Do not cross diagonally.
- Use pedestrian indicators (flashing lights, orange flags, crossing guard, etc.) where ever they are available.
- Do not run out from between parked or stopped cars.
- Wear bright or reflective clothing when walking before the sun rises or after dark.
- Walk on the sidewalk where ever possible. If there is not a sidewalk, walk single file on the shoulder of the road, in the direction facing traffic. Do not walk in the travel lane.



**PROPERTY OWNERS:**

- Keep trees and other shrubbery trimmed up and away from traffic regulatory and advisory signs (stop signs, pedestrian crossing signs, speed limit signs, etc.)



The North Ogden Police Department is seeking citizens interested in volunteering for the Volunteers In Police Service (V.I.P.S.) program.
