#### *Sales Tax & Why Shopping Local Matters*



#### **Please Shop Local**

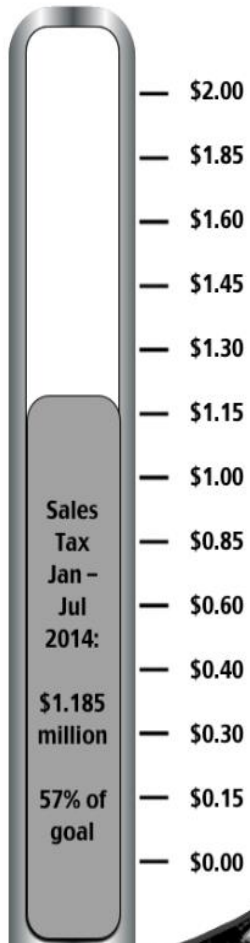
Your sales tax dollars pay for approximately 1/3 of North Ogden government expenditures, and improving sales tax revenues is a great way to help keep property taxes low. We are going to pay sales tax no matter where we shop, so it makes good sense to shop local and keep your tax dollars in North Ogden as much as possible

Support local businesses and your city by shopping in North Ogden!

Under Utah law, cities have two primary taxes to collect money to pay for government services: property tax and sales tax. Sales tax currently funds about 1/3 of North Ogden's government expenses and is more important than ever. During the recession our city—like many families—had to make hard budget choices, including cutting back even important items like road repairs, employee salaries and benefits, motor pool funding, and long-term infrastructure replacement savings. The best way to improve funding for these and other important areas while keeping property taxes low is to boost the city's sales tax revenues by shopping local more often.

We have many great businesses in North Ogden, and we are working hard to bring more. Small changes in our shopping habits can bring big benefits to our city. For example, I used to purchase my gas in another city on my way to work. Once I realized the importance, I made a commitment to always try to purchase my fuel in North Ogden. I was already spending money on gas elsewhere—I just transferred the spending to North Ogden so my sales tax would stay at home.

We have set a goal for 2014 to raise our sales tax revenues to \$2,090,000, a 5% raise over last year. Small changes in our shopping habits can make a big difference for our city finances. Please find a way that you can "Spend It In North Ogden" and keep more of your sales taxes here to support our city.

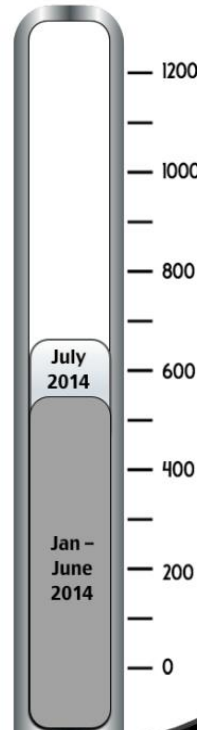

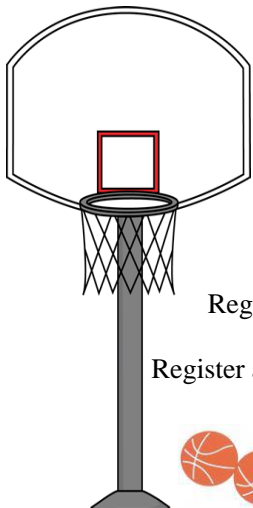

### Green Waste Pick Up

The City has scheduled the fall Green Waste Pick Up for October 27<sup>th</sup> – 31<sup>st</sup>, 2014; collection will be on your regular garbage day. The volume of material may, however, delay collection. The regulations mentioned below must be followed when placing material out for collection. All materials must be in bags, boxes or containers. Bush clippings and small tree limbs must be bundled and no longer than 5 feet in length. Weight limit is 75 pounds. Place materials in parkways, not in curb or waterways. **This is a Green Waste Clean Up Only.**

We appreciate citizen participation and encourage your use of the compost facility. For that reason the **compost facility will be open for your use at NO CHARGE the entire clean-up week (Monday –Friday) from 8am to 4:30pm and Saturday from 9am to 2pm.**

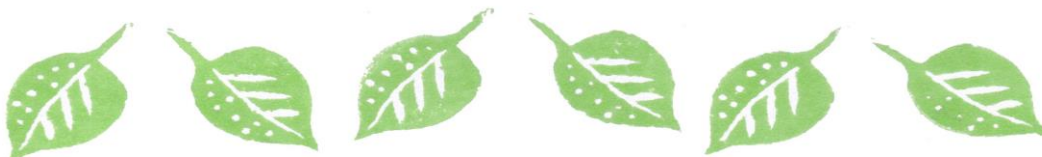
The Public Works Department and City Forester would like to draw your attention to the trees in your yard that overhang the curb and gutter. We ask that you trim those to a minimum height of nine feet (9') above the curb and gutter and eliminate overhang onto the roadway.

Beginning in October, City employees will be around the city trimming those trees that have not been trimmed. The trimming done by the City will be for functionality and may not be esthetically pleasing.

Residents are asked to comply with the requested trimmings for the best results.

The green waste facility is open for the disposal of your trimmings on Mondays and Wednesdays from 3pm to 6pm and Saturdays 9am to 2pm. Pick up a punch pass at the City office during business hours.

We greatly appreciate your cooperation.



- City Code 11-8D-5-A2: "Landscaping materials shall be contained so as not to spill into the public right of way."
- City Code 11-8D-5-A3: "...trees in the park strip shall have a minimum height of seven feet (7') for the lowest branches of the tree when they extend above the curb or sidewalk."
- City Code 11-8D-5-A4: "Any damage to city property created by vegetation will be the responsibility of the property owner."
- City Code 11-10-11-A: "...no fence, hedge, or other similar structure shall be erected in any required front yard of a lot to a height in excess of three and one-half feet (3.5')
