A WORD ON SNOW REMOVAL

The objective is to give direction for timely and efficient removal of snow and ice from streets in North Ogden City. Priority is given to streets which carry the largest traffic volume. Limited resources preclude service on lower priority streets until higher priority streets have been cleared. Motorists should expect snow-packed or icy conditions on lower priority streets during storms of high intensity or long duration and during non-work hours.

Snow plows clear all major collector streets first. After those roads are cleared, the plows begin clearing subdivisions, streets serving schools, City offices, etc. Finally, all other city roads, including dead-end and cul-de-sacs are plowed. Temperatures, storm duration and intensity have a profound effect on the ability of snowplows to clear streets and for salt to melt the snow and ice. The city crews work extremely hard to provide safe and effective snow removal, to increase the efficiency and safety of plowing snow we ask resident to follow a few simple tips:

- 1) Snow removed from driveways and sidewalks not be placed in the road
- 2) Do not park on city streets overnight
- 3) Remove garbage and recycling cans as soon as they are emptied
- 4) Do not stop or attempt to stop plow drivers

North Ogden Public Works continues to accept used motor oil at the maintenance shop located at 332 East Pleasant View Dr. Oil will be accepted during regular business hours Monday-Friday 8:00am to 3:00pm. The oil must be free of any pollutants such as antifreeze, solvents, etc. Please DO NOT leave oil without contacting an employee and providing needed information. Oil that is left without provided information cannot be recycled. Thank you for helping keep North Ogden City environmentally safe.

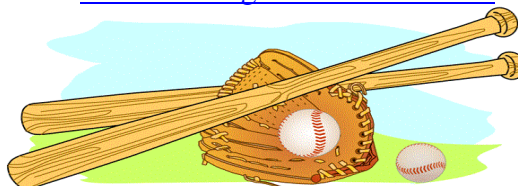
