

ORDINANCE 2012-__

AN ORDINANCE OF NORTH OGDEN CITY AMENDING THE NORTH OGDEN CITY ZONING ORDINANCE SECTION 11-7A-2 SUBURBAN RESIDENTIAL ZONE RE-20 PERMITTED USES:

Section 1. The North Ogden City Zoning Ordinance is hereby amended as follows:
Section 11-7A-2 General Provisions shall be amended to read:

11-7A-2: PERMITTED USES:

Animals or fowl:

- A. On one acre or more, up to five (5) acres, animals and fowl will be limited to four (4) horses, cows, sheep or goats, or combination thereof, per acre. Rabbits up to five (5) per acre shall be permitted.
- B. On more than five (5) acres, an aggregate of a total of two (2) units of group A, B or C, or a combination thereof, may be kept per acre.

Group A: Four (4) horses or cows, or combination thereof.

Group B: Four (4) sheep or goats.

Group C: Five (5) rabbits, or thirty (30) chickens, or thirty (30) pheasants, or ten (10) turkeys, or ten (10) ducks, or five (5) geese, or ten (10) pigeons.

- C. The keeping of swine of any species, including pigs, is not permitted within the corporate limits of the city except two pigs may be kept on a temporary basis on a one acre or larger parcel for up to six (6) months as a 4-H Project.

1. Shade must be provided.

2. Clean, fresh water and fresh feed must be readily available.

3. Adequate inside space must be provided:

a. up to forty (40) pounds – three (3) square feet/per pig

b. forty (40) to one hundred (100) pounds – four (4) square feet/per pig

c. one hundred (100) to one hundred fifty (150) pounds – six (6) square feet/per pig

d. one hundred fifty (150) pounds to market – eight (8) square feet/per pig

5. Adequate outside space must be provided:

a. five (5) square feet under roof/pig minimum and six (6) to fifteen (15) square feet/per pig outside

SECTION 2. This ordinance shall take effect upon adoption.
