GREEN WASTE PICK-UP

The City has scheduled the fall Green Waste Pick Up for October 21st – 25th. Collection will be on your regular garbage day. The volume of material may, however, delay collection.



The regulations mentioned below must be followed when placing material out for collection. All materials must be in bags, boxes or containers. Bush clippings and small tree limbs must be bundled and no longer than 5 feet in length. Weight limit is 75 pounds. Place materials in parkways, not in curb or waterways.

This is a Green Waste Clean-Up Only.

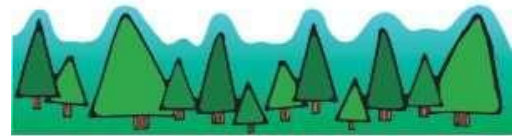

As fall approaches, the Public Works Department and City Forester would like to draw your attention to the trees in your yard that overhang the curb and gutter and ask that you trim those to a minimum height of seven feet (7') above the curb and gutter and overhang no more than one foot (1') onto the roadway.

Beginning in October a representative of the City will be going through neighborhoods and will leave notices on doors if trees are not trimmed to the above regulations. Residents are asked to comply with the requested trimmings or be subject to having the City hire someone at the owner's expense.

If you bundle your limbs after trimming your trees and call 801-782-8111, the City will pick them up at no expense to you. We greatly appreciate your cooperation.



We have added a leaf collection truck to our fleet. This interesting looking truck has a large hose on the side and strong vacuum. We are able to drive along the curb and suck up leaves. If you would like to take advantage of using the leaf collection truck please rake your leaves to the park strip area (this is the area between the sidewalk and curb). Please make sure that this area is free of mailboxes and trees as the arm needs to be free to swing to and fro. **DO NOT** pile your leaves in an area that is landscaped with small rocks as the leaf collector has a very strong vacuum and the rocks may be sucked up and damage the truck.

Please understand that heavy rain or snow will prevent us from using the leaf collector. You can choose to put the leaves at the curb for the next scheduled day or you can bag them up instead.

As I'm sure many of you are aware, school has started up again. We would like to take this time to remind everyone to use extra caution on the roadways, especially as you travel in and around our school zones and other areas where children are present. Children can be fast and dart out into the roadway without warning. Please be mindful of this when you see children out and about. A moment's caution, and perhaps reducing your speed slightly, can save yourself and others years of grief should an accident occur.

North Ogden City has designated school zones throughout the City. Some of these are adjacent to a school; however, some are located several blocks away from the school they serve. Please remember that the speed limit drops to 20 miles per hour any time the amber school crossing lights are flashing. Drivers are also required to stop for the crossing guard any time he or she is in the crosswalk, and must remain stopped until the crossing guard is completely out of the roadway. These individuals provide a valuable service to our community, assuring that our children can get to and from school safely. Please help them out.

We would also like to take this opportunity to remind pedestrians, and parents of pedestrians, about the importance of pedestrian safety. Whenever possible, please walk on the sidewalk or on the road's shoulder off the roadway, and avoid walking in the travel lanes. If there is a crosswalk, it is there for you to use, so please take advantage of it.

If there is not a crosswalk, then we ask that you cross at the nearest corner. In either case, please look both ways and make sure the traffic sees you and has stopped for you before you step into traffic. Don't assume a driver will stop for you, because a wrong assumption can have serious consequences. Please, also avoid crossing mid-block whenever possible.

If you must cross mid-block, you need to yield to motor vehicles. Crossing between adjacent intersections at which traffic-control signals are in operation is considered jaywalking and against the law, unless you are in a marked crosswalk. It is also unsafe. Crossing an intersection diagonally is also prohibited. Please keep in mind that motorists may not see you, or be able to stop in time to avoid hitting you if you are in the roadway, so we ask that you use caution any time you are in or near the roadway.

Remember, vehicles hurt.
