Dear Annette,

I am writing as a Board member of Lakeview Heights HOA in North Ogden.

Several times a year our HOA sponsors social events for our members - movies in January, an Easter Egg hunt, in May a neighborhood garage sale, in summer - a homeowners dinner and a end-of summer family pool party, (with our goal of using North Ogden businesses whenever we can - Walkers, Zeppes, North Shore pool.)

In the past we mailed postcards to our homeowners. But, with over 300 homes that has gotten a little pricey, so to help defer costs we purchased a couple of temporary banners to put out on our common areas to inform our homeowners the week before the event.

For our Easter egg hunt, we put up banners on our common areas at the northeast corner of 3300 N and 450 E, and the northwest corner of 3350 N and 450 E.

After we put up these banners we got a call from Brandon from the North Ogden City and he told us that we needed to get a permit for our signs. Well, I came down to the City offices and talked to a man there and he looked into the ordinances and said there were no rules pertaining to HOA's putting up signs on their own property -- he said we were charting new territory here.

So I'm not really sure what we need to do next. Do we just inform the City Council that we're putting the signs up and when? Or is this something that needs to be dealt with with a new ordinance?

We'd like to be put on the May 24th City Council meeting agenda, as I will be traveling to California for a family wedding on the 10th.
