We wish to thank the North Ogden Civic League, the many businesses in North Ogden and surrounding communities, and the area citizens who supported the North Ogden Police Association's Sub-For-Santa program this last year. Thanks to your assistance, we were able to help provide Christmas for several area families who were in need this holiday season. Thank you for your generosity. Your willingness to get involved helped lighten the holidays for these families. North Ogden City has recently installed new pedestrian-activated crossing lights at 575 E 3100 N. These lights are set to function any time, day or night, and are activated whenever a pedestrian pushes the button. They will remain activated long enough to allow the pedestrian time to safely cross the street. These lights were put in place due to the traffic and pedestrian volume at this intersection. As you approach this intersection, we encourage drivers to use caution, as you would at any intersection, but we also ask that you be extra cautious when these lights are flashing, because there are pedestrians in the area. Below is the Utah Traffic Code pertaining to vehicles and pedestrians in the crosswalk:



41-6a-1002. Pedestrians' right-of-way -- Duty of pedestrian:



- (1) (a) Except as provided under Subsection (2), when traffic-control signals are not in place or not in operation, the operator of a vehicle shall yield the right-of-way by slowing down or stopping if necessary:
 - (i) to a pedestrian crossing the roadway within a crosswalk when the pedestrian is on the half of the roadway upon which the vehicle is traveling; or
 - (ii) when the pedestrian is approaching so closely from the opposite half of the roadway as to be in danger.
- (b) Subsection (1)(a) does not apply under conditions of Subsection **41-6a-1003**(2).
- (c) A pedestrian may not suddenly leave a curb or other place of safety and walk or run into the path of a vehicle which is so close as to constitute an immediate hazard.
- (2) The operator of a vehicle approaching a school crosswalk shall come to a complete stop at the school crosswalk if:
 - (a) a school speed limit sign has the warning lights operating; and
 - (b) the crosswalk is occupied by a person.
- (3) If a vehicle is stopped at a marked crosswalk or at any unmarked crosswalk at an intersection to permit a pedestrian to cross the roadway, the operator of any other vehicle approaching from the rear may not overtake and pass the stopped vehicle.

PUBLIC WORKS DIVISIONS

The **Street Maintenance Division** is responsible for street maintenance and repair; sidewalk and curb maintenance; street sign installation and maintenance; traffic line and legend installation and maintenance.

The **Culinary Water Division** is responsible for the collection, treatment and distribution of water to the entire city. The division operates within the strict federal guidelines and is acknowledged as one of the best water systems in the state.

The **Sewer Maintenance Division** is responsible for maintaining the City's system of sewer lines, cleaning sewer lines, recording lines for maintenance and repair needs.

The **Storm Drain Division** is responsible for all the drain line inspections and maintenance, the maintenance and grooming of all the City's detention basins, and monitoring and control runoff waters.

The **Solid Waste Division** is responsible for the delivery and pick up of all receptacles, the maintenance, repair and replacement of receptacles. Refuse collection is contracted to Waste Management of Utah (801-731-5052).

The **Fleet Maintenance Division** is responsible for the maintenance and repair of City-owned vehicles from the smallest of tools, such as, weed eaters and lawnmowers to the largest equipment, like dump trucks, the backhoe and loader.

The **Public Works Administration** is responsible for the supervision of all projects in all divisions within the Public Works Department. Additionally, all the paperwork generated is funneled through this division for recording and tracking.

We would like to thank the citizens for their assistance in bagging and raking leaves for the public works employees to pick up. Your efforts are a great help to the City and it is greatly appreciated.

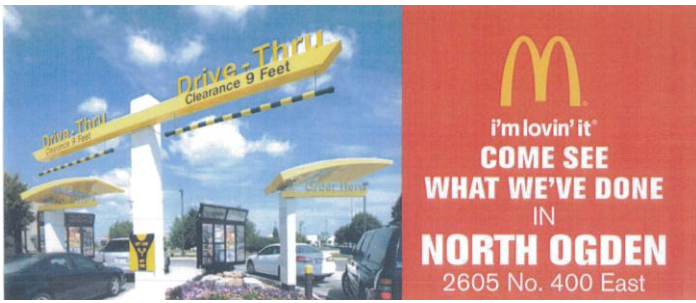

- Despite our best efforts, we occasionally miss scheduled collections. If we do, please call us as soon as you can. We'll try to return on the same day to pick it up, without charge.

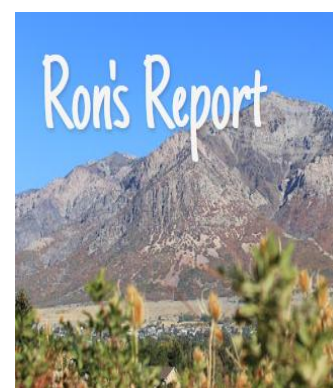
Accepted Items:

- Plastic bags and clear plastic wrap
- Video and cassette tapes
- Shredded paper
- Polystyrene
- Plates, mugs, and pots/pans
- Food, liquids or yard waste
- Food-soiled cardboard, paper cups/plates
- Carpet, cloth or textiles
- Used paper towels/tissues
- Construction/industrial debris
- Electronic waste
- Automobile parts
- Medical/Bio hazardous waste
