Mayor's Message

Shop Local Success: 2015 Sales Tax Revenues Up 18%!

Revenues Nearly \$170,000 Higher Than 2014! • Shop Local & Keep Your Sales Tax \$ Local!

I am thrilled to report that North Ogden sales tax increased substantially in 2015. In particular, our "Point of Sale" sales tax for purchases that occurred in North Ogden City increased a whopping 18%! Our goal is to increase sales tax in order to fund our city's growth without relying on property tax increases, and these new revenues will go towards important services such as police, public works, parks, and roads. **North Ogden has not had a property tax increase for 7 years and if we shop locally and raise the City's sales tax revenues, we can keep it that way.** Please remember to shop at North Ogden businesses as much as possible. For example, since becoming Mayor, I have made a special effort to always fill my gas tank in North Ogden. This small change did not really take much more time or cost any more money—but it does mean that my sales tax \$ are staying in my own city. We pay sales tax no matter where we shop—*let's all make an effort to keep as much of those sales tax dollars in our home city!*

City Pride Spring Clean Up

We are planning our 2nd Annual City Pride Spring Clean Up for May 7-14th. During this event there will be free green waste disposal, electronics/appliance recycling, disposal of large trash items, free tire disposal, etc. Last year was a huge success. North Ogden prohibits dogs being unrestrained by a leash or fence when outside. Unrestrained dogs are at greater risk of being injured or killed, and also cause risks to pedestrians, motorists and other animals. Dog owners are also required to clean up their dogs' feces when they take their dogs for walks. Please be considerate of your neighbors. Please keep your dogs restrained at all times and clean up after them. City ordinances allow for a maximum of two dogs per household, unless a resident obtains a kennel permit from the North Ogden City Council. *Effective March 1st, 2016, dog licenses from 2015 are past due. A late fee will be applied to overdue license renewals. These fees, however, are less expensive than an expired license citation.

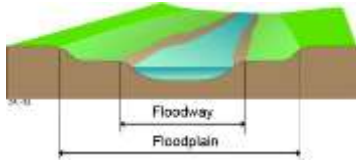

You will need a Green Waste punch pass to enter. Passes will be sold to residents at the City Office or Public Works Facility during office hours (8:00 am to 5:00 pm Monday thru Friday, except holidays) you may purchase a pass for \$25.00. The pass is good for 10 (non-consecutive) days.

ACCEPTED MATERIALS

(materials not listed WILL NOT be accepted)

Woody Materials: vines, bushes, twigs, limbs, fitters and logs up to 12" in diameter. Stumps are not accepted. Woody tree material will be chipped, ground or burned.

Compost Materials: soft (non-woody), un-bagged vegetative material (ie. Grass clippings, leaves, pine needles, sawdust and shavings, weeds).

Fill Materials: soil, rock, sod, brick, and concrete (prior approval needed).

Pickup of wood chips and mulch items will be charged as when you purchased your punch card. You may pick those items up during the mentioned operating hours.

Please obey all signage at compost facility to assure proper placement of items and assist in keeping the facility clean and organized.

Green Waste PICK UP

May 9-13, 2016

Collection scheduled for regular garbage day, pending volume of materials collected.

Regulations: Materials must be boxed/bundled with string or bagged. Bush and tree limbs must be bunched at less than 5 feet in length. Weight limit 75 lbs. Place materials in parkways, not in curbs or waterways.

This is a Green Waste Clean Up Only.

The compost facility is open at no cost May 9-13, 2016 from 8:00am to 4:00pm in addition to the regular volunteer hours on Monday, Wednesday and Saturday.
