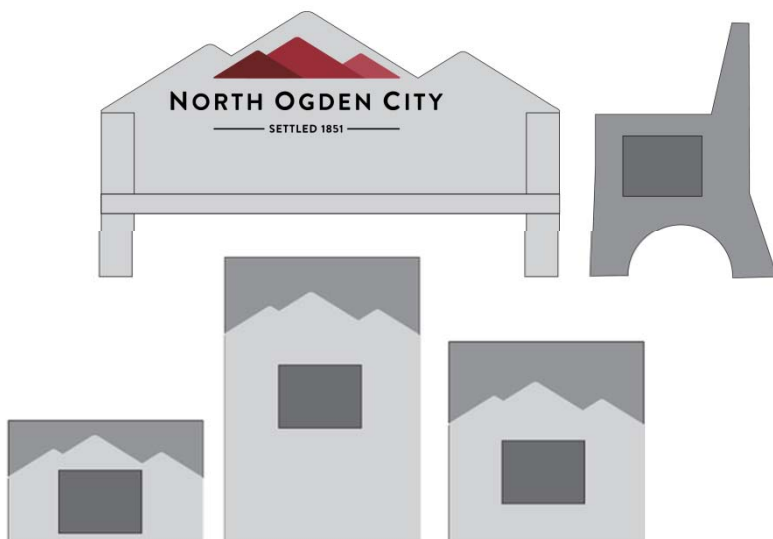

The Tri-City Youth Court convened for their first trial on March 17th in the North Ogden City Council Chambers. Youth Court is a diversion program which provides an alternative disposition for cases involving juvenile offenders. Youth from North Ogden, Pleasant View, and Harrisville Cities who appear before the Tri-City Youth Court have been identified as candidates that can be appropriately addressed outside the juvenile court process.

Youth courts give communities an opportunity to provide immediate consequences for first-time offenders by offering a peer-driven sentencing mechanism that allows young people to take responsibility, be held accountable, and make restitution. Youth courts allow young people to take ownership for their actions in a way that benefits the community, provides court volunteers hands-on knowledge

of the criminal justice system, and enhances their education and career opportunities.

We anticipate using student volunteers from Weber High, North Ogden Jr High, and Orion Jr High schools to serve as judges, clerks, and bailiffs. Youth who commit offenses such as truancy, tobacco possession, vandalism, curfew violations, and other juvenile status offenses, may, at the discretion of the investigating police officer, principal, or other person in authority, be referred to the Tri-City Youth Court rather than Juvenile Court. Most of our youth deserve to have their first low-level legal transgression serve as a learning experience, rather than a negative mark that could haunt them for the rest of their lives.

You will need a Green Waste punch pass to enter. Passes will be sold to residents at the City Office or Public Works Facility during office hours (8:00 am to 5:00 pm Monday thru Friday, except holidays) you may purchase a pass for \$25.00. The pass is good for 10 (non-consecutive) days.

ACCEPTED MATERIALS

(materials not listed WILL NOT be accepted)

Woody Materials: vines, bushes, twigs, limbs, fitters and logs up to 12" in diameter. Stumps are not accepted. Woody tree material will be chipped, ground or burned.

Compost Materials: soft (non-woody), un-bagged vegetative material (ie. Grass clippings, leaves, pine needles, sawdust and shavings, weeds).

Fill Materials: soil, rock, sod, brick, and concrete (prior approval needed).

Pickup of wood chips and mulch items will be charged as when you purchased your punch card. You may pick those items up during the mentioned operating hours.

Please obey all signage at compost facility to assure proper placement of items and assist in keeping the facility clean and organized.

The compost facility is open at no cost May 9-13, 2016 from 8:00am to 4:00pm in addition to the regular volunteer hours on Monday, Wednesday and Saturday.

North Ogden City Residents (verified by Driver’s License or North Ogden Utility Bill) may drop off any of the following items to the Green Waste Facility (2750 N Mountain Road) for free during the week of the Spring Cleanup:

Large Household Trash Items

(Furniture, mattresses, bed frames, etc)

Green Waste Items

Paint (must be dried with Kitty Litter first)

Cardboard and plastic for recycling (glass must be thrown in the trash)

Appliances and electronics

Car Batteries

- Used oil will be accepted at Jiffy Lube and Auto Zone
- Car tires can be taken to Big O Tires

The following items will NOT be accepted:

- Commercial waste or dumping
- Hazardous waste or material
- Household garbage that belongs in your residential garbage can

Once the permit has been issued a copy will be sent electronically to North View Fire District. A burn permit will need to be obtained for each individual burn you may wish to have. Open burns will need to be supervised by a responsible individual and will have on site means to extinguish the fire, such as a garden hose, shovel or a fire extinguisher with a 4A rating or higher. The burn permit will need to be on hand for all open burns and all open burns will need to be extinguished prior to nightfall.

Please remember and take into account that if the smoke emissions are offensive to occupants of surrounding properties or the fire is deemed hazardous then the fire becomes a public nuisance and will need to be extinguished. Each one of our fire officers have the authority to extinguish any fire they deem to be a nuisance or if the rules are not followed.
