Green Waste Pick up

The City has scheduled the spring Green Waste Pick Up for May 2-6, 2011; collection will be on your regular garbage day. The volume of material may; however, delay collection a day or two.

The regulations mentioned below **MUST** be followed when placing material out for collection. All materials must be in boxes, bundled with string or bagged. Bush clippings and small tree limbs must be bundled and no longer than 5 feet in length. Weight limit is 75 pounds. Place materials in the parkstrip, not in curb or waterways.

This is a Green Waste Clean Up Only.

The compost facility is open at no cost this week from 8:00am to 4:00pm in addition to the regular volunteer hours on Monday, Wednesday and Saturday.

Green Waste Facility Opening

The compost facility located at 2700 North and Mountain Road, will open on April 2, 2011.

The hours of operation are:

 Mondays and Wednesdays	3:00pm-6:00pm
Saturdays	9:00am-noon

It will be closed hunting season and all government holidays.

Green Waste passes will be sold to residents at the City Office. During office hours (9:00 am to 5:30 pm Monday thru Friday, except holidays) you may purchase a pass for \$25.00. The pass is good for 10 (non-consecutive) days.

ACCEPTED MATERIALS:

Woody Materials: vines, bushes, twigs, limbs, fitters and logs up to 12" in diameter. Stumps are not accepted.

Compost Materials: soft (non-woody), unbagged vegetative material (ie. grass clippings, leaves, pine needles, sawdust and shavings, weeds, farm animal manure).

Fill Materials: soil, rock, sod, brick, block, asphalt and concrete (prior approval needed).

Materials not specifically listed above will not be accepted. The woody tree material will be chipped or ground. Both the wood chips and aged compost materials will be available, free of charge, to North Ogden City residents while supplies last. You may pick those items up during the mentioned operating hours.

This program is operated entirely by volunteer residents of North Ogden. We thank the volunteers from last season and encourage you to be a volunteer this season. NORTH OGDEN POLICE DEPARTMENT

The North Ogden Police Department hates to be the bearer of bad news, but contrary to the common email scam, there is not an attorney in Nigeria or elsewhere, who is seeking your assistance in helping his wealthy client get his money out of the country. You also have not won an international lottery that you have never entered, and legitimate companies will not pay you in advance for work you have not performed. These are just a few of the common frauds which are circulating around our area at any given time. We understand that many citizens are seeking ways to supplement their incomes due to the current economy, but we wish to remind you that any legitimate company will not require you to pre-pay before you receive an award or business opportunity.



While there are legitimate work from home opportunities, groups such as the Mystery Shopping Providers Association remind people to "never cash a check sent to you in advance of an assignment...that's a sure sign the deal is a scam." Legitimate companies will not pay you in advance for this type of service. Our area has also started receiving complaints after citizens receive phone calls from "family members" who claim to have been arrested or stranded somewhere, asking for help with bail or money to help them return home. If you receive these types of calls, ask the caller personal questions that only a legitimate family member would know, and before sending any money, confirm with other family members that the "stranded" person is actually where the caller said they are.

A third common fraud we see regularly involves private or online sales. If you chose to sell your property, do not accept payment for more than the value of the item sold, and never agree to return overpayment to the sender or any other person. Fraud artists commonly use this ploy to make purchases, sending a check for more than the amount of purchase, with instructions to use a money transfer service, such as Western Union, to return the amount in excess of the agreed upon price. Only after victims have sent the money do they find out from their bank that the check they had deposited is counterfeit. Unfortunately, not only has the victim lost their property, but they are also put in a position where they must repay the bank the money they wired. The criminals involved in these types of crimes are often outside the country, and are difficult, if not impossible to track down and prosecute. If you feel you are being solicited by someone seeking to defraud you, do not respond to them.
