

**OFFICIAL PUBLIC NOTICE OF PRIMARY ELECTION
WEBER COUNTY PRIMARY ELECTION - TUESDAY, JUNE 28, 2016**

The 2016 Primary Election will be held on Tuesday, June 28, 2016. The rules for participating in a Primary Election are set by the political parties and not by the Elections Office. Ballots will be mailed out to eligible voters, according to voter's party affiliation, on or before June 7th. Voters must be 18 years old or older, citizens of the United States, and residents of the voting precinct in which they are voting.
