MAYOR'S MESSAGE

Library Renovation & Skate Park

After months of negotiations and discussions, we reached a compromise agreement with Weber County to move the library renovation forward. North Ogden City has agreed to donate the current Skate Park property for the library to create a new parking lot. Weber County has agreed to pay the full cost to relocate the Skate Park to another piece of city property. Weber County has also agreed to pay to build angled parking along 475 East. North Ogden agrees to expand the parking lot at the Senior Center within the next 8 years by approximately 70 stalls, to provide additional parking in the overall area. I want to thank Commissioner James Ebert for working with us to find an agreement that was fair to all sides. And huge thanks to the Mayors and Council Members from Pleasant View and Harrisville for their strong support through the entire process. Our three cities came together to ask for a better plan for our citizens and while we did not achieve everything we wanted, **we reached a far better outcome than was originally planned.**

Possible locations under consideration for the new **Skate Park** are: the Community Gardens just east of the current Skate Park, northeast corner of North Ogden Park, and Wadman Park. A committee has been formed to review options and the City Council will then make a decision. Contact us to provide your input!

Road Work

Summer is all about fireworks & parades, family BBQ's, and . . . road work. Because of the \$3/month "Transportation Utility Fee," and the increase in the state gas tax, North Ogden City will be doing over \$1 million in road work this summer—**more than any previous year in recent city history.** We will be doing chip seal overlays on 7 of the 10 busiest roads in the city, including: 2100 N, Elberta Dr., 3100 N., 1050 E., 3300 N., 3550 N., 450 East above 3100 N., and various neighborhood streets. We are using a new and improved synthetic chip that is lightweight and does not damage cars when kicked up. Many of these roads will receive a "leveling course" to smooth out patches in the asphalt before they are overlaid. In addition to making the roads more drivable, this massive amount of road work will significantly improve the lifespan of many of our most important roads. We will also be doing a large amount of crack sealing and other road work in multiple areas. Please watch the city website and Facebook pages for details about upcoming projects and **drive carefully** in the many construction zones that will be active throughout the summer and early fall!

THEFT PREVENTION

In recent weeks, North Ogden has experienced an increase in thefts throughout the city. One group that was focusing on stealing items from vehicles was caught, thanks to the assistance of alert neighbors. In each of these thefts, the vehicles had been left unlocked.

There have been several other thefts as well where utility trailers, bicycles, and tools were stolen. In the majority of these cases, the items were left unlocked, or unsecured in a yard or open garage. The easiest way to reduce the likelihood of becoming a victim is to be proactive and secure your property.

While this will not prevent all thefts and burglaries, most criminals do not want to draw attention to their activities by making noise breaking windows or kicking in doors. In talking to people we've arrested, we've been informed that these criminals will often check doors and windows, and if property is secure, they will move on to other, easier targets.

However, if high-value items such as purses, computers or cell phones are visible, they will often take greater risks to steal your valuables. Motion lights, surveillance cameras and alarms are also



effective theft deterrents. We strongly encourage residents to watch out for your neighbors. An officer may patrol your area and see someone who appears to be working in a garage or vehicle, but we often don't know if that person lives at that address, however, you do. Many crimes are prevented or solved thanks to observant neighbors. If you see something suspicious report it to our dispatch center immediately at 801-629-8221 or call 9-1-1 to report an emergency.


